

Conditions of Entry & Waiver

- 1) I attest that I am physically fit and that my bike is in a sound mechanical order prior to undertaking the event. I understand that cycling on public roads is a potentially hazardous activity.
- 2) During this event I agree to wear a cycling helmet, abide by the road rules, obey the directions of Police officers, route marshals and ride with care and consideration of others on the road.
- 3) Safety precautions undertaken by organisers (such as course supervision, ride safety briefings) are a service to me and other participants but are not a guarantee of safety.
- 4) In consideration of the Fraser Coast BUG permitting me to enter and participate in the Cardno River to River Ride on 1st & 2nd May, 2010, and as a condition of such entry, I release the Fraser Coast BUG, its servants or agents from all claims for injury, loss or damage of whatever kind I might suffer as a result of any acts or omissions whether negligent or otherwise of the Fraser Cost BUG its servants or agents in relation to the event.
- 5) A cycling adult must accompany children under the age of 16. Children under the age of 12 must not pilot their own bike.
- 6) I have listed my date of birth, emergency contact details and any condition from which I may suffer that might affect my performance or be relevant if medical treatment is needed. I accept the risk of participating despite these conditions.
- 7) I consent to receiving any medical treatment including ambulance transportation that the event organisers think desirable on or at the event.
- 8) My registration is not transferable to other people. I agree that if the event is cancelled or the event format and/or course is altered due to inclement weather or other 'Acts of God' or conditions and safety concerns outside the control of the event organiser, or if I do not participate in the event for any other reason my entry fee shall be non-refundable.
- 9) I consent to event organisers using my name, image and likeness before, during and after the event for event promotional broadcasting or reporting purposes in any media.

I certify that I am 18 years or older and I have read this document and fully understand it. As a parent or guardian of the participant, I agree to the above for myself and on behalf of my child. I indemnify and will keep indemnified all people and corporations associated with the conduct of the event on the terms referred to.
